



2009 Artist Application Information

Thank you for your interest in being part of the Celebration of Fine Art. You may return the application package at any time. There is no deadline for entry. However, studios are filled and artists are juried on a first come first served basis so early entry will increase your chances of acceptance. The show fills quickly. We jury the previous artists who wish to return to the event prior to considering new applications. The previous artists are juried in early April. There is no application fee.

How the jury process works:

We select work that we feel will be a good fit with the existing artists. We offer our visitors a wide variety of art and always consider the mix of art and artists as part of the jury process. We select the highest quality work available that is submitted by new artists. We look for saleable work in a variety of price ranges. The work must be original and completed by the artist. Only a limited number of reproductions are allowed (see contract page 2). We also consider how much time you plan to spend at the event. We promote the show as a venue where people can see artists at work. We understand that depending on the type of work you do this has some limitations but, the more you are there the more you will sell. The objective of this event is art sales.

Fees for studios are \$2400.00 to \$2,550.00 for the entire time of the event, based on location (see Floor Plan). In addition to the studio fee, the Celebration of Fine Art will take a 20% commission on all sales. You do not need a tax license or business license since all sales are processed through our central office. We collect all taxes in the office.

Check to see that the 2009 Celebration of Fine Art dates are cleared on your calendar.

Complete and mail

- 2 page, *signed*, application form. (sign both pages please)
- CD with .jpg image files or 10 slides or photos of your work similar to what you intend to exhibit.
(Please be sure to mark the slides, photos or CD with your name)
- 1 page biography.
- 1 page artist statement including your experience doing shows and selling you own work.

Mail the complete package and include a postage paid return envelope. If postage and envelope aren't large enough to return CD and other materials those will not be returned.
